

RESOLUTION NO. 604

AUTHORIZING PROCEEDINGS TO ESTABLISH THE
CORNVILLE IRRIGATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Yavapai County through its Board of Supervisors pursuant to Chapter 338, 36th Legislature, 2nd R.S., Laws of 1984, may authorize proceedings to create a special district before expiration of the special district moratorium in effect until December 31, 1986, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Cornville Ditch Associate, Inc., have applied in writing to the Board of Supervisors requesting permission to begin proceedings to create a special district, and;

WHEREAS the following compelling reasons for formation have been established:

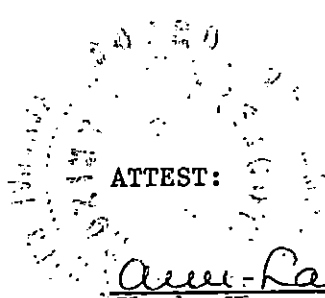
1. The district would give the Board of Directors of said district more authority to administer the efficient delivery of water among district members;
2. The district would provide advantages in improving water conservation along the ditch, according to the Soil Conservation Service;
3. The district would be a stronger legal entity in dealing with the pending adjudication of water rights, and thereby increase the districts' ability to keep water in Yavapai County as opposed to losing it to metropolitan areas;
4. The district would provide a base for future expansion to other districts in the Verde Valley should they find such a district advantageous;
5. The Cornville Ditch Association, Inc. membership has approved proceedings to form a special irrigation district;

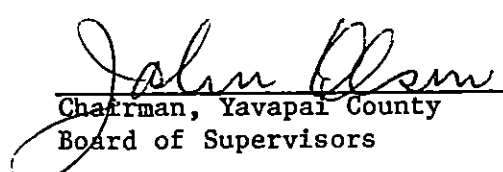
6. The concept of forming a district has the support of the Cooperative Extension Service and the Verde Natural Resource Conservation District.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that permission is granted to begin proceedings for the formation of the Cornville Irrigation District.
