The above matter came before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its meeting on September 4, 1984, at the request of Ned J. Peters to abandon all of Second Street lying between Lot 16, Block 2 and Lot 1, Block 4; and all of that portion of the alley lying north of Lots 9 through 16, Block 2; Lots 1 through 13, Block 4, and parallel and adjacent to said Lots, and as bounded by the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, Humboldt, Arizona, to vest with the adjacent properties, and not with Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company. The County Engineer has submitted a report and recommended the abandonment. The Board of Supervisors determined that the abandonment of these portions of Second Street and the alley will not leave any property without access to public roads and streets of Yavapai County, and is no longer necessary for public use, and the same should be granted.

And it further appeared that due and regular notice of the proposed abandonment was duly and regularly given by publication on August 24, 1984, and posted, and proof of such publication has been made and filed with the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: (1) that the request for abandonment

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of portions of Second Street and an alley, Humboldt, Arizona, as described herein, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be and the same is granted; (2) that the vacated portions of Second Street and an alley, shall vest with the adjacent properties and not with Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company; and (3) that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded along with an abandonment plat map in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.
