A RESOLUTION SETTING TIME FOR HEARING ON PETITIONS FOR ORGANIZATION OF DIAMOND VALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT APPROVING BOND, AND DIRECTING THAT NOTICE BE GIVEN.

WHEREAS, Duly verified petitions of a majority of the persons owning real property within the limits of the proposed District have been filed with the Board of Supervisors requesting formation of

The Diamond Valley Improvement District

WHEREAS, Cash bond in the amount of \$250.00 has been filed with the Board of Supervisors as required by A.R.S. Sec. 11-704 to pay expenses connected with the proceedings in case the District is not established.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED:

- 1. That the submitted bond is approved.
- 2. That a hearing on the petitions shall be held on Monday, October 22, 1984, at 11:30 o'clock a.m., in the Board of Supervisors meeting room on the third floor of the County Administration Building, 255 East Gurley Street, Prescott, Arizona, at which time interested property owners may be heard on any matter relating to the establishment of the proposed district.
- 3. Notice of the Hearing shall be given by:
 a. Public posting of Notices at intervals of no more than three hundred
 feet apart along the streets within the proposed district for not less than
 ten (10) days prior to the date of hearing. The County Engineer shall post
 such notices.
 - b. By publication twice in a newspaper of general circulation published in Yavapai County, Arizona, such publications to be one week apart, and the first publication to be not less than ten days prior to the date of hearing.
 - c. By the Clerk of the Board sending, not less than fourteen days prior to the hearing date, a copy of such notice by first class mail to the home address of each absentee property owner within the proposed district who provides his current address to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to A.R.S. \$11-705, C and D.
