

RESOLUTION NO. 637

PROVIDING FOR THE PARTICIPATION OF
YAVAPAI COUNTY IN QUALIFIED ADULT DAY CARE

WHEREAS, Yavapai County recognizes that a substantial portion of its population is made up of older citizens who enhance the quality and productivity of Yavapai County to a greater degree when they remain outside of an institutionalized environment; and

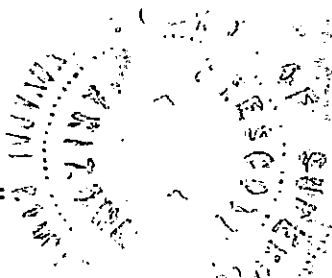
WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. §11-267, Yavapai County may implement programs to provide adult day care to disabled persons or persons sixty years of age or older; and

WHEREAS, programs are available in Yavapai County which provide adult day care and could provide it to County indigents if additional funding was available;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. Yavapai County will participate in providing adult day care for indigents as defined by A.R.S. §11-297 and certified as indigents by the Medical Relief and Aid Office.
2. Adult day care will be provided only when a physician certifies that if a person did not participate in adult day care, twenty-four hour long term care would be required.
3. The Medical Relief and Aid Office shall administer the program and review eligibility in accordance with the rules and regulations applied to the County indigent sick. However, adult day care is a social program and is not a medical expense for purposes of determining net income.
4. Any facility providing adult day care must be certified and licensed by the Arizona Department of Economic Security pursuant to A.C.R.R. R6-5-76.
5. Yavapai County will provide adult day care not to exceed twenty hours per week per person and pay an amount not to exceed \$3.25 per hour of care per person.
