RESOLUTION OF ABANDONMENT

Resolution No. 641

The above matter came before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its meeting on February 25, 1985, at the request of George and Edna Richards to abandon that portion of Second Street lying between Lot 25, Block 17 and Lot 1, Block 18; Lot 26, Block 16 and Lot 32, Block 15; and Lot 25, Block 16, and Lot 1, Block 15, Humboldt, Arizona, as recorded on Map 2, page 9, of Maps and Plats in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, to vest in the abutting property owners.

The County Engineer has submitted a report and recommended the abandonment. The Board of Supervisors determined that the abandonment of the above describes portion of Second Street will not leave any property without access to public roads and streets of Yavapai County, and is no longer necessary for public use, and the same should be granted.

And it further appeared that due and regular notice of the proposed abandonment was duly and regularly given by publication on February 11, 1985, and posted, and proof of such publication has been made and filed with the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: (1) that the request for abandonment of the above described portion of Second Street, Humboldt, Arizona, and as

shown on the attached Exhibit A, be and the same is granted; (2) that the vacated portion of a street shall vest in the abutting property owners; (3) that rights of way or easements of existing sewer, gas, water or similar pipelines and appurtenances and for canals, laterals or ditches and appurtenances, and for electric, telephone, and similar lines and appurtenances shall continue as they existed prior to the disposal or abandonment thereof; and (4) that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded along with an abandonment plat map in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.
