The above matter came before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its meeting on February 25, 1985, at the request of Yavapai County Engineer Joseph Sarvis to abandon that portion of Old State Highway 279 from the Quail Springs Road in Section 23, T15N, R3E, southerly to the westerly right-of-way line of new State Highway 279 in Section 5, T14N, R4E, as abandoned to Yavapai County by the Arizona State Highway Commission on September 15, 1964, in Resolution #64-66, Yavapai County, Arizona, to vest in the abutting property owners. The County Engineer has submitted a report and recommended the abandonment. The Board of Supervisors determined that the abandonment of the above described highway will not leave any property without access to public roads and streets of Yavapai County, and is no longer necessary for public use, and the same should be granted.

And it further appeared that due and regular notice of the proposed abandonment was duly and regularly given by publication on February 13, 1985, and posted, and proof of such publication has been made and filed with the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: (1) that the request for abandonment of the above described portion of Old Highway 279, Yavapai County, Arizona, as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be and the same is granted; (2) that the vacated portion of Old Highway 279 shall vest in the abutting properties; and (3) that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.
