

RESOLUTION NO. 648

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING COUNTY VEHICLE USE

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors is the governing body of Yavapai County; and,

WHEREAS, the Internal Revenue Service, on January 1, 1985, issued a ruling on taxation of fringe benefits with which Yavapai County must comply;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that no County vehicle will be used for commuting between the employee's station of duty and home. This policy excludes those deputy sheriffs who are assigned to remote duty areas, and those employees in the Road Departments assigned to remote duty areas. Remote duty employees cannot use the County vehicle for personal use.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors will decide, on an individual basis, any other use or exception to this policy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all use will be subject to I.R.S. regulations.
