

RESOLUTION NO. 657

AMENDING INDIGENT HEALTH CARE ASSET AND INCOME STANDARDS

WHEREAS, Yavapai County has a limited responsibility to provide health care for the indigent sick of the County; and

WHEREAS, definitions and mandates in Arizona statutes are inconsistent with present Yavapai County indigent health care standards; and

WHEREAS, Yavapai County desires to adopt an indigent health care system which properly relates to the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. Section 6.0 of the Yavapai County Medical Relief and Aid Eligibility Manual is repealed and shall be amended to state as follows:

Only indigents are qualified for medical relief. An "indigent" is a resident of the county who does not have resources of all persons in the household, including but not limited to equity in a house or car, with a net worth in excess of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000), with no more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) cash or other liquid assets, as defined by the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System.

2. Sections 7.01 and 7.02 of the Yavapai County Medical Relief and Aid Eligibility Manual are repealed and Section 7.01 shall be amended to state as follows:

For the purposes of calculating eligibility for County hospitalization and medical care of the indigent sick, the annual income of an individual shall be determined by multiplying by four the income for the three months immediately prior to application.
