RESOLUTION _ 700

ESTABLISHING THE PROCEDURE FOR PUBLIC ROADWAY NAME CHANGES

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors is the governing board of Yavapai County, and;

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors has jurisdiction over certain public roadways in the County;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the following procedures are adopted for changing the names of public roadways:

A. Initiation of hearing.

Any person may initiate hearings to change the name of a public roadway within Yavapai County by filing with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors or the County Engineer a petition containing the signatures and mailing addresses of at least 51% of the property owners abutting the roadway, together with the names and addresses of all adjacent property owners and service and emergency organizations that serve the public who did not sign the petition. The list of adjacent property owners and their addresses must be certified to be correct to the best of the petitioner's knowledge. The petition must contain a summary of the action requested, the old name, the new name, the number of plat or map which identifies the roadway, a description

that includes the location of the beginning and the end, and a map of the roadway which is the subject of the petition.

B. Notice of Hearing.

Upon receipt of the petition, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall set a hearing date before the Board of Supervisors which shall be the earliest date which will allow adequate notice to the public. Notice of hearing shall be mailed by first class mail to those persons whose name appears on the petition and list submitted under paragraph A. supera, at least two weeks prior to the hearing. In addition, notice of the hearing shall be published once in the County newspaper and once in a newspaper with a general circulation in the area of the proposed disposition, if available, at least one week prior to the hearing. Notices of the hearing shall be posted at the beginning and the end of the roadway and at all intersections.

C. Application Fee.

At the time the petition is submitted, the petitioners must pay an application fee of \$100.

D. Protests.

Any person may appear and protest the requested action at the hearing or submit written protests at least 24 hours in advance of the hearing. Once the petition has been submitted, any person signing the petition may protest the action, but no signature may be withdrawn.

E. Action by the Board of Supervisors

At the hearing, the Board of Supervisors may grant the request by resolution, or deny the request, or hold the matter until a stated time and date for further consideration.

F. Exceptions

The Board of Supervisors may elect to initiate a roadway name change without the filing of a petition and to waive any requirement of this resolution.
