WHEREAS, duly verified petitions of a majority of the persons owning real property within the limits of the proposed annexation to the District have been filed the Board of Supervisors requesting annexation to the Big Park Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, a cash bond in the amount of \$250.00 has been filed with the Board of Supervisors as required by A.R.S. §11-704 to pay expenses connected with the proceedings in case the annexation is not approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED:

1. That the submitted bond is approved.
2. That a hearing on the petitions shall be held on Monday, April 20, 1987, at 11:15 o'clock a.m., in the Board of Supervisors meeting room on the third floor of the County Administration Building, 255 East Gurley Street, Prescott, Arizona, at which time interested property owners may be heard on any matter relating to the establishment of the proposed annexation to the district.
3. Notice of the Hearing shall be given by:
 - a. Public posting of Notices at intervals of no more than three hundred feet apart along the streets within the proposed annexation for not less than ten (10) days prior to the date of the hearing. The County Engineer shall post such notices.
 - b. By publication twice in a newspaper of general circulation published in Yavapai County, Arizona, such publications to be one week apart, and the first publication to be not less than ten (10) days prior to the date of hearing.

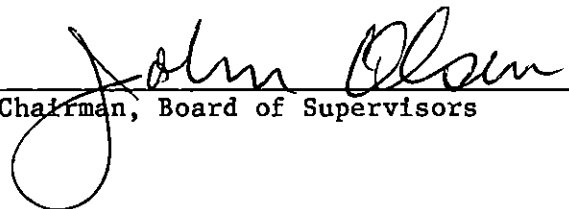

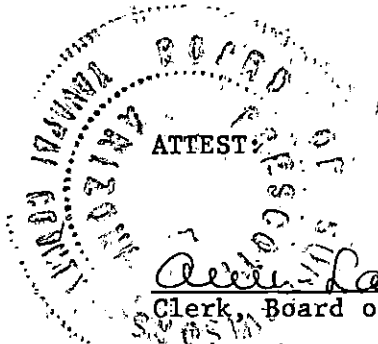
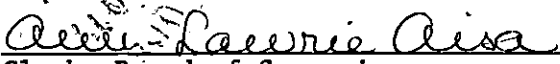
