ENDORSING PROPOSED RULES ESTABLISHING METHODS
TO BE USED BY ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ALLOCATE
HIGHWAY USER REVENUE FUNDS

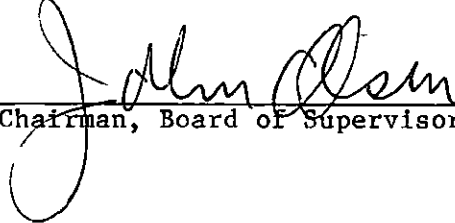
WHEREAS, controversy has existed among the counties of the State of Arizona as to the proper methods to be used by the Arizona Department of Transportation to distribute Highway User Revenue Funds to the counties; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation proposes to adopt the attached rules to establish the methodology they will follow in determining distribution of Highway User Revenue Funds to the various counties; and

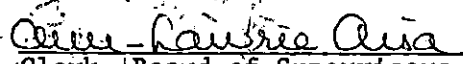
WHEREAS, the proposed rules will resolve the existing disputes between the Counties;
