

RESOLUTION NO. 736

SUPPORTING AND ENCOURAGING THE DESIGNATION OF OLD HIGHWAY 66
FROM SELIGMAN TO TOPOCK AS AN HISTORIC ROAD

WHEREAS, the highway commonly known as "Old Route 66" is of great historical significance and value to Yavapai County and to the State of Arizona and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Route 66 Association has applied to the State of Arizona for designation of this highway as an Historic Road; and

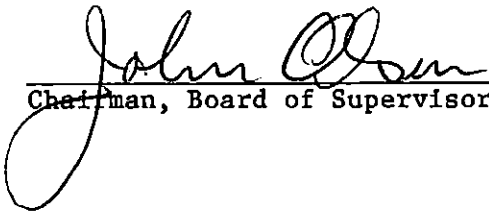
WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors to support the Association in its efforts to obtain this designation and to cooperate with the state and the association in the implementation of this worthwhile project; and

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors recognizes that such designation would result in economic benefit to the areas through which the highway passes; and

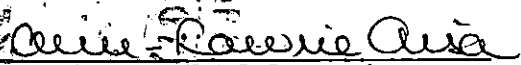
WHEREAS, this resolution does not constitute a representation that Yavapai County will maintain this roadway at any particular standard or make any improvement thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors fully supports and encourages the designation of Old Highway 66 from Seligman to Topock as an Historic Road and that it will take whatever action may be reasonable necessary to facilitate this designation.
