OF THE LAND & WATER CONSERVATION FUND

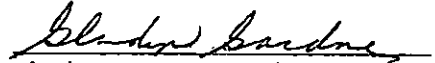
WHEREAS, Yavapai County has benefited in the past from funding under the Land & Water Conservation Fund in the total amount of \$201,707.82; and

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors considers this assistance for parks and recreational centers to be of great benefit to the residents of Yavapai County; and

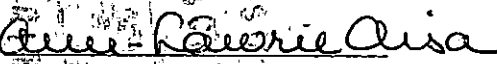
WHEREAS, a bill is being prepared for introduction to the United States Congress which would revitalize the Land & Water Conservation Fund;
