RESOLUTION NO. 756

Amending Chapter 11, Section 11.40 of the Yavapai County Medical Relief and Aid Manual

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Legislature has passed legislation known as Senate Bill 1182, Section G, adopting new resource standards for eligibility for long term care and has attached to that legislation an emergency clause making it effective on March 1, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to amend Chapter 11, Section 11.40 of the Yavapai County Medical Relief and Aid Manual, which governs resource standards for eligibility, in order to be in compliance with S.B. 1182, Section G.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

Persons requiring care in excess of a ninety (90) day period, consisting of placement in a licensed nursing home, licensed supervisory home or a certified adult foster care facility, shall meet the resource requirements necessary to qualify for Supplemental Security Income to the aged, blind or disabled.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective March 1, 1988, in compliance with S.B. 1182, Section G.
