## RESOLUTION NO. 778

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, MAKING A COMMITMENT TO THE PURPOSE STATEMENT OF THE VERDE RESOURCE ASSOCIATION AND AGREEING TO PROVIDE REPRESENTATION TO THE ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS, the Verde Resource Association became a standing committee of Cocopai RC&D, Inc. on October 28, 1988; and

WHEREAS, Yavapai County is an entity located within the defined boundaries of the Verde Resource Association; and

WHEREAS, the County of Yavapai is interested in protecting the resources of the Verde River Watershed in the State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, Yavapai County recognizes that growth will continue in the Verde River Watershed and that only through a combined regional planning effort of all groups and governmental agencies can the resources be protected.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Yavapai, Arizona, that the County of Yavapai supports the Verde Resource Association's efforts to protect the resources of the Verde River Watershed in the State of Arizona; and

THAT Yavapai County will join and appoint a representative to the Verde Resource Association for this purpose.
