A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT
TO PROHIBIT THE DESECRATION OF THE AMERICAN FLAG

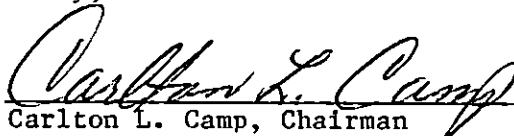
WHEREAS, on June 21, 1989, the United States Supreme Court handed down its decision in the case Texas v. Gregory Lee Johnson, upholding the right of an individual to burn an American flag; and

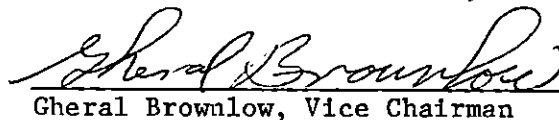
WHEREAS, in response to the decision of the Supreme Court, President George Bush has issued a call for a Constitutional Amendment which would prohibit the desecration of the American flag; and

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors wishes to make known its belief that the American flag is not only the foremost symbol of our common heritage as Americans and of all that our form of government represents, but that it also stands as a symbol of freedom throughout the world.

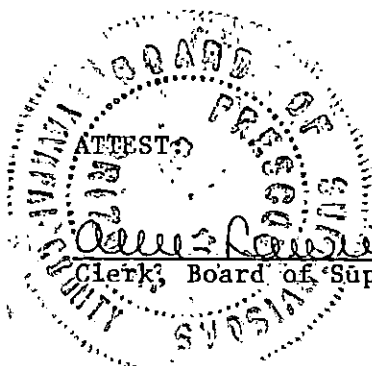

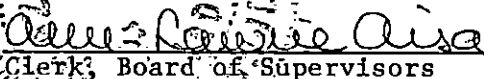
