

RESOLUTION NO. 798

TO DESIGNATE APRIL 1990 AS " FAIR HOUSING MONTH"

WHEREAS, the year 1989 marks the twentieth - first anniversary of the passage of Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 as amended (commonly referred to as the "Federal Fair Housing Act"), declaring a national policy to provide for fair housing throughout the United States;

WHEREAS, the Federal Fair Housing Act prohibits discrimination in housing on the basis of race, color, religion, sex or national origin;

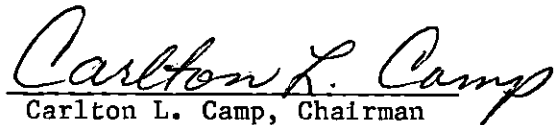
WHEREAS, fairness is the foundation of our way of life and reflects the best of our traditional American values;

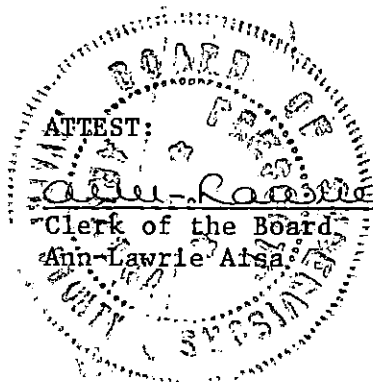
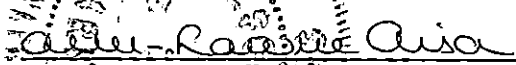
WHEREAS, the insidious discriminatory housing practices undermine the strength and vitality of America and her people,
