## RESOLUTION NO. 799

## A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE BURNING OF HAZARDOUS WASTE AT THE PHOENIX CEMENT PLANT NEAR CLARKDALE, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community has applied to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality for a permit to burn hazardous waste at its Phoenix Cement Plant located near Clarkdale, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, no assurance has been given that hazardous waste will not be imported from other states for burning at the Phoenix Cement Plant or that such wastes will not be stored and blended on-site prior to burning; and

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors is concerned for the health, safety and welfare of all persons living in the Verde Valley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors joins the Town of Clarkdale and the Town of Jerome in opposing the burning of any hazardous waste material at the Phoenix Cement Plant.
