

RESOLUTION NO. 824

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, YAVAPAI COUNTY,
ARIZONA, ENDORSING THE FORMATION OF THE
PRESCOTT AREA WILDLAND/URBAN INTERFACE COMMISSION
IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRESCOTT;
AND HEREBY AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND STAFF
TO TAKE ALL STEPS DEEMED NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE ABOVE

WHEREAS, one of the most urgent challenges facing the citizens of Yavapai County area communities is the effect of residential and commercial development in and adjacent to forest and chaparral lands; and

WHEREAS, the Wildland/Urban Interface includes lands governed by both the City of Prescott and Yavapai County; and

WHEREAS, both governing bodies recognize the need to identify, prioritize and guide the management of Wildland/Urban Interface issues in the Prescott area; and

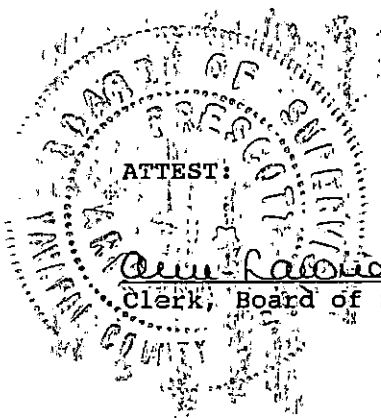
WHEREAS, it is further recognized that only through a cooperative effort among these governing bodies and the citizens of the communities involved can the multi-faceted challenges posed by development of the wildland areas in Prescott be successfully addressed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY:

THAT, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors hereby endorses the formation of the Prescott Area Wildland/Urban Interface Commission, whose mission will be to advise local government in the identification and prioritization of Wildland/Urban Interface issues; and

THAT, the Yavapai County Administrator is hereby authorized to take all steps deemed necessary to accomplish the above.
