

RESOLUTION NO. 828

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE FORMATION ELECTION HELD WITHIN THE PROPOSED SEDONA OAK CREEK JOINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT OF YAVAPAI/COCONINO COUNTIES, ARIZONA, ON DECEMBER 11, 1990; DETERMINING THAT THE FORMATION OF THE DISTRICT WAS APPROVED BY A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST BY THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS IN BOTH YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AND COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA; AND DECLARING THAT THE SEDONA OAK CREEK JOINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER JUNE 30, 1991.

WHEREAS, the Chairmen of the Boards of Supervisors and the Superintendents of Schools of Yavapai and Coconino Counties, Arizona, have heretofore canvassed the results of the formation election held in and for the proposed Sedona Oak Creek Joint Unified School District of Yavapai/Coconino Counties, Arizona, on December 11, 1990, in accordance with the provisions of Section 15-450(F), Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended, a copy of the canvass being attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and

WHEREAS, Section 15-450(F), Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended, provides that if a majority of the votes cast in each county of persons who reside within the proposed district favors formation of the proposed joint unified school district, the boards of supervisors shall jointly declare the election and the joint unified school district shall become operative from and after June 30 next following the election;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Boards of Supervisors of Yavapai and Coconino Counties, Arizona, do hereby declare the following:

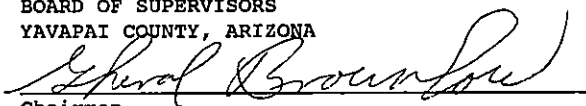
Section 1. That upon examination of the canvass of the returns of the election made by the Chairmen of the Boards of Supervisors and the Superintendents of Schools of Yavapai and Coconino Counties, Arizona, regarding the formation election held within the proposed Sedona Oak Creek Joint Unified School District on December 11, 1990, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", the Boards of Supervisors of Yavapai and Coconino Counties, Arizona, hereby determine and declare that a majority of the votes cast in both Yavapai County and in Coconino County on the question of the formation of the proposed District by the qualified electors of said proposed District were cast in favor of the creation of the Sedona Oak Creek Joint Unified School District.

Section 2. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-450(F), Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended, the Sedona Oak Creek Joint Unified School District shall become operative from and after June 30, 1991.

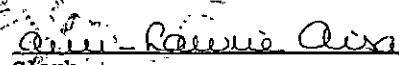
Section 3. That the boundaries of the Sedona Oak Creek Joint Unified School District are set forth in Exhibit "B", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
