RESOLUTION NO. 832

ESTABLISHING SEVERAL STREETS AND ROADS AS COUNTY HIGHWAYS

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on January 14, 1991, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following roads or portions of roads as County highways is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of their establishment:

District 1:

BULLOCK ROAD (aka Forest Service Road #123) as shown on the General Highway Map of Yavapai County, Arizona, Arizona Highway Department (1967), page 1, beginning at its intersection with State Highway 89, in Section 23, T21N, R2W, G&SRB&M; thence westerly to the westerly right of way of the A.T. & S.F. Railway, a distance of approximately 2.5 miles. See attached Exhibit A.

PHEASANT PLACE, in its entirety, as dedicated in Book 8, page 7 of Maps and Plats, Chino Heights Subidivision; Book 8, page 18 of Maps and Plats, Chino Heights II; and Book 8, page 30 of Maps and Plats, Chino Heights III, beginning at its intersection with Yuma Drive, thence westerly to its intersection with Cherokee Drive. See attached Exhibit B.

ROAD 3 NORTH, beginning at its intersection with Yuma Drive, Chino Heights V, Chino-Heights, as shown in Book 8, page 52 of Maps and Plats; thence easterly and adjacent and north of the south line of Section 8, T16N, R2W, G&SRB&M, to its intersection with Reed Road, as shown in Book 16, page 57 of Maps and Plats, Shadow Mountain Unit One. See attached Exhibit B.

YUMA DRIVE, in its entirety, as dedicated in Book 8, page 7 of Maps and Plats, Chino Heights Subdivision; Book 8, page 32 of Maps and Plats, Chino Heights IV; and Book 8 page 52 of Maps and Plats, Chino Heights V; beginning at its intersection with Antelope Drive (aka Road 4 North), thence southerly to its terminus at the southeast corner of Section 7, T16N, R2W, G&SRB&M. See attached Exhibit B.

THIS Document is being rerecorded to correct the legal for Road 3 North.

District 2:

CHITTENDEN STREET, in its entirety, as dedicated in Book 5, page 8 of Maps and Plats, Deck Subdivision; and Deck's Second Subdivision, as shown in Book 5, page 25 of Maps and Plats; beginning at its intersection with State Highway 71, thence southerly to its intersection with Sunrise Road (aka Sunset Road). See attached Exhibit C.

CONGRESS WAY, as shown on Book 5, page 8 of Maps and Plats, Deck Subdivision; and Book 5, page 25 of Maps and Plats, Deck's Second Subdivision; beginning at its intersection with State Highway 71; thence southerly to its intersection with Sunrise Road (aka Sunset Road). See attached Exhibit C.

District 3:

LOOKOUT POINT ROAD, in its entirety, as dedicated in Book 7, page 71 of Maps and Plats, Rimrock Acres Subdivision, beginning its intersection with Valley Vista Road; thence northerly to its intersection with Beaver Creek Road (aka Stoneman Lake Road), as shown in Book 12, page 6 of Maps and Plats. See attached Exhibit D.

PRESCOTT STREET, in its entirety, as dedicated in Book 2, page 9 of Maps and Plats, Revised Town of Humboldt; Book 2, page 17 of Maps and Plats, Wells' Addition to Town of Humboldt; Book 2, page 84, Placer Addition to Humboldt Townsite; and shown as an Unnamed Street (aka Prescott Street), on Map 2, page 63, Additional Survey of the Wells Addition to the Town of Humboldt; and as described in Book 1827, page 849 of Official Records; beginning at the westerly subdivision line as shown in Book 2, page 9; thence easterly to its intersection with Lazy River Drive, as shown in Book 7, page 5, Lazy River Acres Subdivision. See attached Exhibit E.

All above stated recordations are on record at the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the above described roads, and as shown on the attached Exhibits A, B, C, D, & E be designated and established forthwith as County highways.


