## RESOLUTION NO. 857

ANTELOPE DRIVE AND AN UNNAMED EASEMENT NAME CHANGED TO YUMA DRIVE

WHEREAS, a petition has been received by the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors from the Yavapai County Engineer's Office, to change the name of that portion of Antelope Drive, Chino Lakes No. 1, as recorded in Book 7 Page 33, to Yuma Drive, beginning at the south subdivision line, thence running northerly to the north subdivision line; and that portion of roadway locally known as Antelope Drive, an easement as recorded in Book 847 Pages 153-154 and Book 847 Page 155, 50 feet-wide, located in Chino Ranches No. 1, as recorded in Book 8 Page 83 of Maps and Plats to Yuma Drive, said easement beginning at the south subdivision line, thence running northerly and adjacent to the easterly subdivision line to the north subdivision line; all of the above recordation are on file in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the existing names of Antelope Drive, Chino Lakes No. 1 and an unnamed easement, Chino Ranches No. 1, are confusing to the public and to responding emergency vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County declares that the name of Antelope Drive as described above and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be changed to Yuma Drive; and the name of the unnamed easement as described above and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, will be named Yuma Drive.
