MULLEN WAY (A PORTION) AND SHERIFF'S POSSE ROAD NAMES CHANGED TO SHERIFFS POSSE TRAIL

WHEREAS, a petition has been received by the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors from Donald M. and Violette M. Levenson, to change the name of that portion of Mullen Way, also known as South Mullen Way and Sheriff's Posse Road, beginning at the north line of Section 18, Township 13 North, Range 2 West, G&SRB&M, Yavapai County, Arizona, thence southeasterly to the Forest Service boundary on the west line of U.S. Department of Interior Lot 5, Section 18, Township 13 North, Range 2 West, G&SRB&M; and the petition of the Yavapai County Public Works Director to changed the name of Sheriff's Posse Road beginning at the City of Prescott boundary, the north line of U.S. Department of Interior Lot 23, thence southwesterly through said Lot 23 and continuing southwesterly through U.S. Department of Interior Lot 27, Section 7, Township 13 North, Range 2 West, G&SRB&M, and more fully described and recorded in easements to Yavapai County in Book 434, page 1, and Book 547, page 210, of Official Records in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder; and

WHEREAS, the name on the above described portion of Mullen Way is confusing to the public and to responding emergency vehicles, and the name on the above described portion of Sheriff's Posse Road is not consistent with that portion extending through Timber Ridge West Subdivision;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County declares that the names of Mullen Way and Sheriff's Posse Road, as described above, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, both be changed to Sheriffs Posse Trail.

This name change shall become effective 60-days after the date approved by the Board of Supervisors.
