RESOLUTION NO. 916

OLD STATE HWY. 279 NAME CHANGED TO CAMINO REAL

WHEREAS, a petition has been received by the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors from the County Engineer's office, to change the name of a portion of Old State Hwy. 279; beginning at the north subdivision boundary of Verde Village Unit 6, as recorded in Book 15 Pages 39 and 40 of Maps and Plats, on record in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona; thence southerly to the south subdivision boundary of Verde Village Unit 7, as recorded in Book 15 Pages 43 and 44 of Maps and Plats, on record in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the existing name of Old State Hwy. 279 is confusing to the public and to responding emergency vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County declares that that portion of Old State Hwy. 279 as described above and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be changed to Camino Real.

This name change shall become effective 60-days after the date approved by the Board of Supervisors.

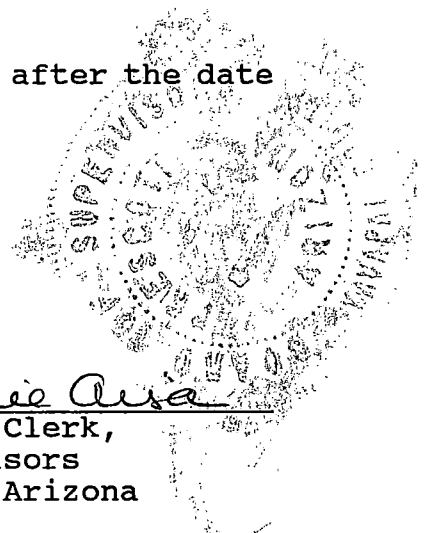
