## **RESOLUTION NO. 1067**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE YAVAPAI COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION PRESCRIBING QUALIFICATIONS FOR BOARD OF EQUALIZATION HEARING OFFICERS

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Equalization is authorized, pursuant to A.R.S. §42-241, to appoint hearing officers for the purpose of reviewing petitions filed under the provisions of A.R.S. §42-241.01; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. §42-241, the Yavapai County Board of Equalization is authorized to prescribe qualifications for board of equalization hearing officers; and

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Equalization desires to attract and retain the best qualified individuals available to serve as board of equalization hearing officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT any person serving as a hearing officer for the Yavapai County Board of Equalization shall have experience in at least one of the following areas:

- Real estate appraisal or sales.
- 2. Hearing property valuation appeals at the county or state level.
- 3. Arbitration.

In addition, any person serving as a hearing officer for the Yavapai County Board of Equalization shall be a resident of Yavapai County. All persons serving as hearing officers shall participate at least annually, and more often if so directed, in valuation review classes provided by the State Board of Equalization.
