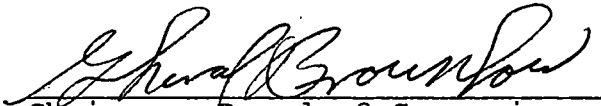
ESTABLISHING A PORTION OF ROAD 5 NORTH AS A COUNTY HIGHWAY

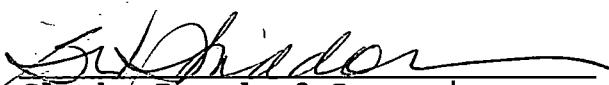
