

RESOLUTION NO. 1076

**DECLARING THE SUPPORT OF THE
YAVAPAI COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
FOR THE CONTINUED SUPPORT OF THE
ARIZONA PIONEERS' HOME**

WHEREAS, the Arizona Pioneers' Home and State Hospital for Disabled Miners were established by Acts of the Arizona State Legislature in 1909 and 1929 respectively; and

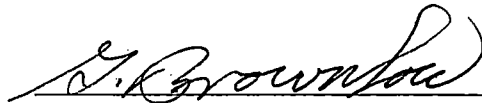
WHEREAS, for many years the Arizona Pioneers' Home has provided a haven for Arizonans who have lived and worked in Arizona for at least 30 years and who are over the age of 65, or who have been actively engaged in mining, are over the age of 60 and unable to support themselves, or have become incapacitated due to mining activities; and

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors recognizes and appreciates the contributions to the community made by residents of the Arizona Pioneers' Home prior to their residency there, as well as the contributions those residents now make by virtue of their presence in our community; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Pioneers' Home is historically significant to Yavapai County and continues to provide an extremely valuable service not only to the residents of Yavapai County but also to the State of Arizona.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors supports the continued operation of the Arizona Pioneers' Home and urges the State Legislature to provide whatever support is necessary to ensure the continued operation of this most valuable institution.
