PRESCOTT STREET, TOWN OF HUMBOLDT,
ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION

The above matter came before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its meeting on November 10, 1997, at the request of Mr. John Thurman, chairman of the Dewey - Humboldt Association to abandon Prescott Street, a portion of street, between Lots 1 thru 6, Block 21, and Lots 22 thru 25, Block 23, Town of Humboldt, Yavapai County, Arizona, as dedicated in Book 2 Page 9 of maps and Plats, to vest in the abutting properties, pursuant to A.R.S. §28-1902.

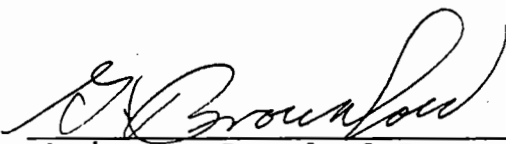
The County Engineer has submitted a report and recommended the abandonment. The Board of Supervisors determined that the abandonment of the portion of street will not leave any property without access to public roads and streets of Yavapai County, and is no longer necessary for public use, and the same should be granted.

And it further appeared that due and regular notice of the proposed abandonment was duly and regularly posted, and an affidavit of such posting has been made and filed with the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: (1) that the request for abandonment of the portion of Prescott Street, Town of Humboldt, Yavapai County, Arizona, as described herein be and the same is granted; (2) that the vacated portion of street shall vest in the abutting properties, pursuant to A.R.S. §28-1902; (3) that rights of way or easements of existing sewer, gas, water or similar pipelines and appurtenances and for canals, laterals or ditches and appurtenances, and for electric, telephone, and similar lines and appurtenances shall continue as they existed prior to the disposal or abandonment thereof; and (4) that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded along with an abandonment plat map in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.
