**A RESOLUTION OF THE YAVAPAI COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
PERMANENTLY CLOSING CITIZENS CEMETERY TO
FUTURE BURIALS**

WHEREAS, Citizens Cemetery located on Sheldon Street in Prescott, Arizona, is a County-owned cemetery; and

WHEREAS, Citizens Cemetery has been placed on the National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS, the exact locations of numerous existing burials in Citizens Cemetery are unknown; and

WHEREAS, since October 2, 1933, Citizens Cemetery has been closed to burials except where ownership of a recorded plot with portions of the plot unused is vested in the name of the owner; and

WHEREAS, Yavapai County is not obligated to allow any additional burials at Citizens Cemetery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in order to ensure that the remains of those individuals who are currently buried in Citizens Cemetery are not disturbed, and to protect and preserve this historic cemetery, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors declares Citizens Cemetery permanently closed to any future burials of bodies or of cremated remains.
