ESTABLISHING PURPLE SAGE ROAD AS A COUNTY HIGHWAY

Yavapai County Map On Demand

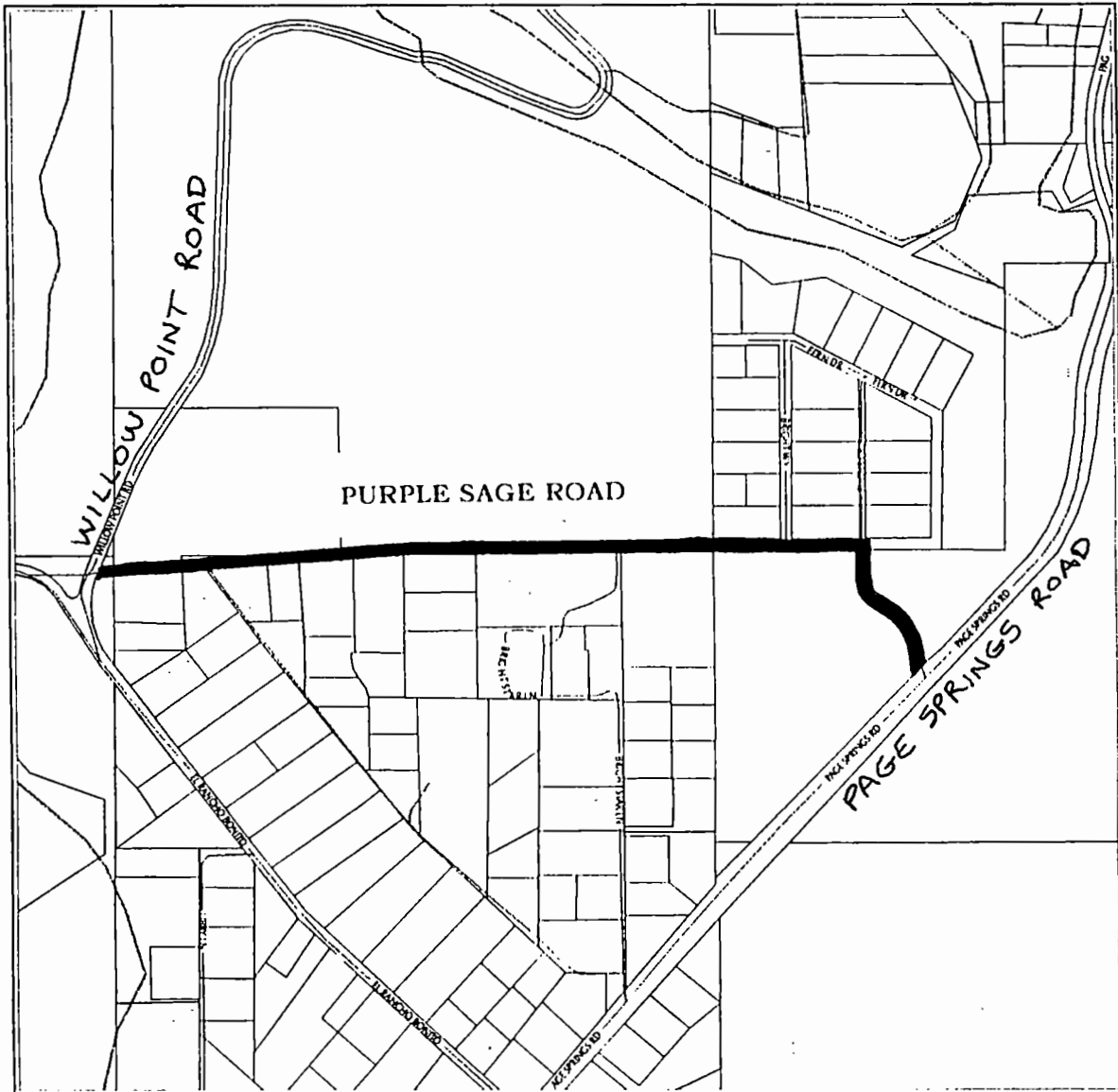
