

RESOLUTION NO. 1214

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE FULL-TIME PAID YAVAPAI COUNTY ATTORNEY'S INVESTIGATORS WHO ARE CERTIFIED PEACE OFFICERS REGULARLY ASSIGNED TO HAZARDOUS DUTY TO ENTER INTO A JOINDER AGREEMENT WITH THE ARIZONA PUBLIC SAFETY PERSONNEL RETIREMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yavapai did, on May 17, 1999, pass Resolution No. 1180 authorizing an actuarial survey to be made to determine the estimated cost of participation in the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary actuarial survey has been made and it has been deemed in the best interest of the County of Yavapai to include all full-time, paid Yavapai County Attorney's Investigators who are certified peace officers and regularly assigned to hazardous duty under the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System Act as set forth in Title 38, Chapter 5, Article 4, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended 1988.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yavapai that the Yavapai County Attorney's Investigators be authorized to sign a Joinder Agreement with the Arizona Public Safety Personnel Retirement System Fund Manager.
