RESOLUTION NO. 1218

BARIL WAY CHANGED TO MESA GRANDE DRIVE

WHEREAS, G. Thomas Tyo, project manager of Canyon Mesa Country Club Phase III, petitioned the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors to consider changing Baril Way to Mesa Grande Drive;

WHEREAS, Baril Way is a private roadway recorded in Book 39 Page 13 of Maps and Plats, and is located in the Village Oak Creek area, running south from Canyon Creek Lane for approximately 200 feet, more or less;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was set for the Board of Supervisors to consider changing the private roadway name Baril Way on February 22, 2000;

WHEREAS, a notice of this hearing was published in the Verde Independent and the Red Rock News on February 16, 2000, posted along the roadway, and mailed to all adjacent property owners, Yavapai County Sheriff's Office, Sedona Fire Department, Sedona Post Office, and the other related agencies;

WHEREAS, with the support of the Yavapai County Sheriff's Office, Sedona Fire Department, and the County Engineering Department the Board of Supervisors will considered changing Baril Way to Mesa Grande Drive;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on February 22, 2000 to consider changing the referenced roadway name. No comment from the public was given, therefore the Board of Supervisors unanimously voted approval of the proposed change.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County declares Baril Way, as described above and illustrated on the attached exhibit A, be changed to Mesa Grande Drive.

These name changes shall become effective 60 days after the date approved by the Board of Supervisors
