

RESOLUTION NO. 1223

**TO DESIGNATE THE MONTH OF MARCH AS
AMERICAN RED CROSS MONTH IN YAVAPAI COUNTY**

WHEREAS, disaster trained volunteers assisted 30 individual families meeting emergency needs with food, clothing, shelter and medical assistance following fires and floods; and

WHEREAS, 1,365 people received life saving training and certification in First Aid and CPR; and

WHEREAS, 547 people received Red Cross water safety training; and

WHEREAS, approximately 587 participants received red cross HIV/aids education helping people prevent the spread of the deadly virus; and

WHEREAS, Red Cross Reserve a Ride transportation volunteers drove almost 23,000 miles to transport 557 disabled, elderly and low-income individuals to their doctor and social service appointments; and

WHEREAS, more than 240 people were served through emergency communications for military service members, financial assistance, counseling and information and referral; and

NOW, THEREFORE, The Yavapai County Board of Supervisors does hereby proclaim March 2000 as

"AMERICAN RED CROSS MONTH IN YAVAPAI COUNTY"
