RESOLUTION NO. 1235

ESTABLISHING A PORTION OF YUMA ROAD AS A COUNTY HIGHWAY

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on May 15, 2000, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following road as a County highway is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of its establishment:

YUMA ROAD, Hassayampa Mountain Club Plat C, as dedicated in Book 3 Page 41 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Arroyo Drive, formerly known as Maricopa Drive, thence northerly to the beginning point of the abandonment recorded in Book 5 Page 117 of Maps and Plats.

All above stated recordations are on record at the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the above described road, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be designated and established forthwith as a County highway.
