RESOLUTION NO. 1241

ESTABLISHING SEVERAL STREETS AND ROADS AS COUNTY HIGHWAYS

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on June 5, 2000, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following roads as County highways is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of their establishment:

INDIAN RUIN ROAD, Ridgeview, as dedicated in Book 13 Page 38 of Maps & Plats, beginning at its intersection with Creek Rock Road, thence easterly to the northeasterly side of Morningside Drive.

LINDSAY WAY, Oak Creek Country Club Estates Unit I, as dedicated in Book 21 Page 50 of Maps & Plats, beginning at its intersection with Kiabab Way, thence westerly, thence westerly through Oak Creek Country Club Estates Unit 2, as dedicated in Book 22 Page 55, thence northwesterly to the northwesterly subdivision line.

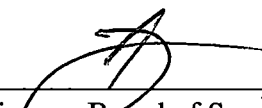
KIABAB WAY, Oak Creek Country Club Estates Unit I, as dedicated in Book 21 Page 50 of Maps & Plats, beginning at the north subdivision line, thence southerly, thence southwesterly through PARCEL F, SEDONA GOLF RESORT, as dedicated in Book 33 Pages 38-39 to its intersection with Ridge Rock Road.

All above stated recordations are on record at the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona.

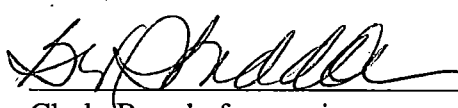
