RESOLUTION NO. 1304

BRADSHAW MOUNTAIN ROAD,
AUTHORIZING THE TAKING BY EMINENT DOMAIN
A PORTION

The above matter came before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its September 4, 2001 meeting to authorize the taking by eminent domain of a portion of Bradshaw Mountain Road.

WHEREAS, Yavapai County is a political subdivision of the State of Arizona and is authorized by the Arizona Constitution to acquire property by eminent domain for public purposes, and;

WHEREAS the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors on this date was presented with information demonstrating that the taking by eminent domain of the property described in the attached Exhibit "A" was necessary for public road and transportation purposes within Yavapai County;

IT WAS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

- 1. That the taking by eminent domain of the property described in the attached Exhibit "A" was necessary for public road and transportation purposes.
- 2. That the Yavapai County Attorney is authorized to proceed with the necessary actions to acquire and condemn the subject property and obtain possession thereof.
