

RESOLUTION NO. 1346

DECLARATION OF DROUGHT EMERGENCY BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, Yavapai County has experienced several years of below normal precipitation which has significantly reduced water supplies, and

WHEREAS, conditions now exist that have created a critical shortage of water and feed for ranchers and farmers throughout the County, and

WHEREAS, the commerce of Yavapai County is based significantly on ranching, and agriculture, and

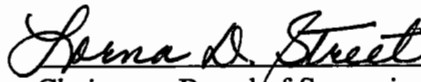
WHEREAS, the drought endangers property and livestock in Yavapai County, and

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors has the authority, pursuant to A.R.S. §26-311, to declare that a local emergency does exist within Yavapai County due to severe drought.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a local emergency currently exists in Yavapai County due to the server drought conditions.

Passed and adopted this 20th day of May, 2002.

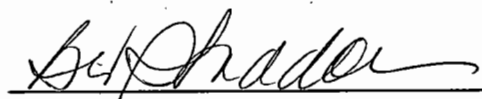
