ESTABLISHING VERDE RANCH ROAD AS A COUNTY HIGHWAY

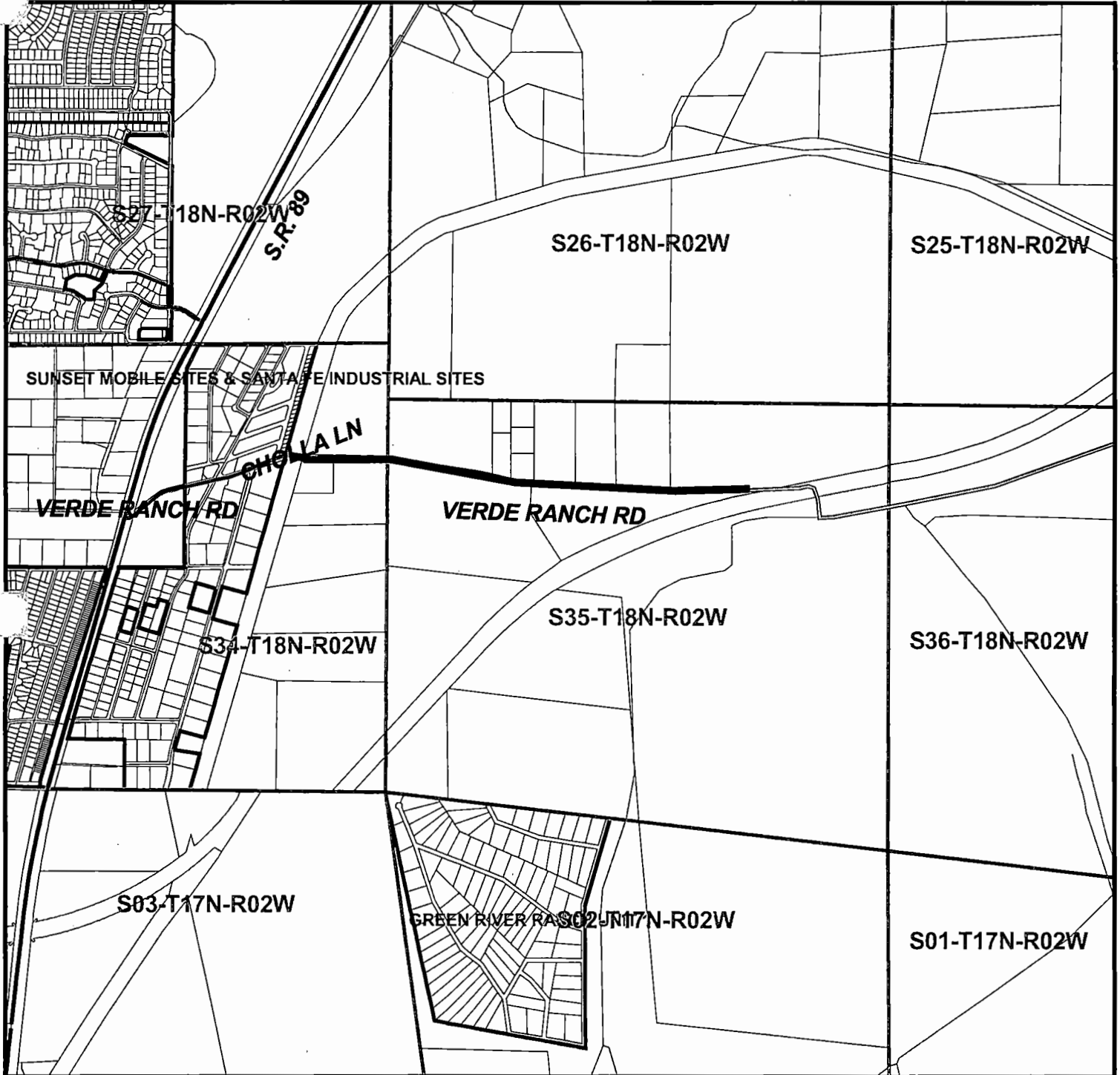
