

RESOLUTION NO. 1381

ESTABLISHING VARIOUS ROADS AS COUNTY HIGHWAYS

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on January 6, 2003, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following roads as County highways is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of their establishment:

CORRAL ROAD, Income Unit of Hassayampa Mountain Club, as dedicated in Book 3, Page 71 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Sundown Road, thence northwesterly through Mile High Properties No. 4, as dedicated in Book 5, Page 9 of Maps and Plats, thence northwesterly through Mile High Properties No. 5, as dedicated in Book 5, Page 10 of Maps and Plats to its intersection with West Skyview Drive, formerly known as Sunlit Drive, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

OAK LANE, Mile High Properties No. 4, as dedicated in Book 5, Page 9 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Corral Road, thence easterly to a line which runs between the north corner of Lot 2, Block B and the southeast corner of Lot 6, Block C of Mile High Properties No. 4, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

PIMA DRIVE, Prescott East Unit Three, as dedicated in Book 13, Page 63 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Sunset Lane, thence northeasterly, thence easterly through Prescott East Unit 1 Amended, as dedicated in Book 13, Page 12 of Maps and Plats and Prescott East Unit One as dedicated in Book 12, Page 2 of Maps and Plats, to its intersection with Starlite Drive, and as shown on the attached Exhibit B.

INDIAN HILL DRIVE, Valley High, Indian Meadows Addition, as dedicated in Book 7, Page 21 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Antelope Drive, thence easterly to its intersection with Indian Hill Drive South, and as shown on the attached Exhibit C.

INDIAN HILL DRIVE SOUTH, Valley High, Indian Meadows Addition, as dedicated in Book 7, Page 21 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Indian Hills Drive, thence southerly, thence easterly to its intersection with Manzanita Blvd., and as shown on the attached Exhibit C.

All above stated recordations are on record at the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the above described roads, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be designated and established forthwith as County highways.

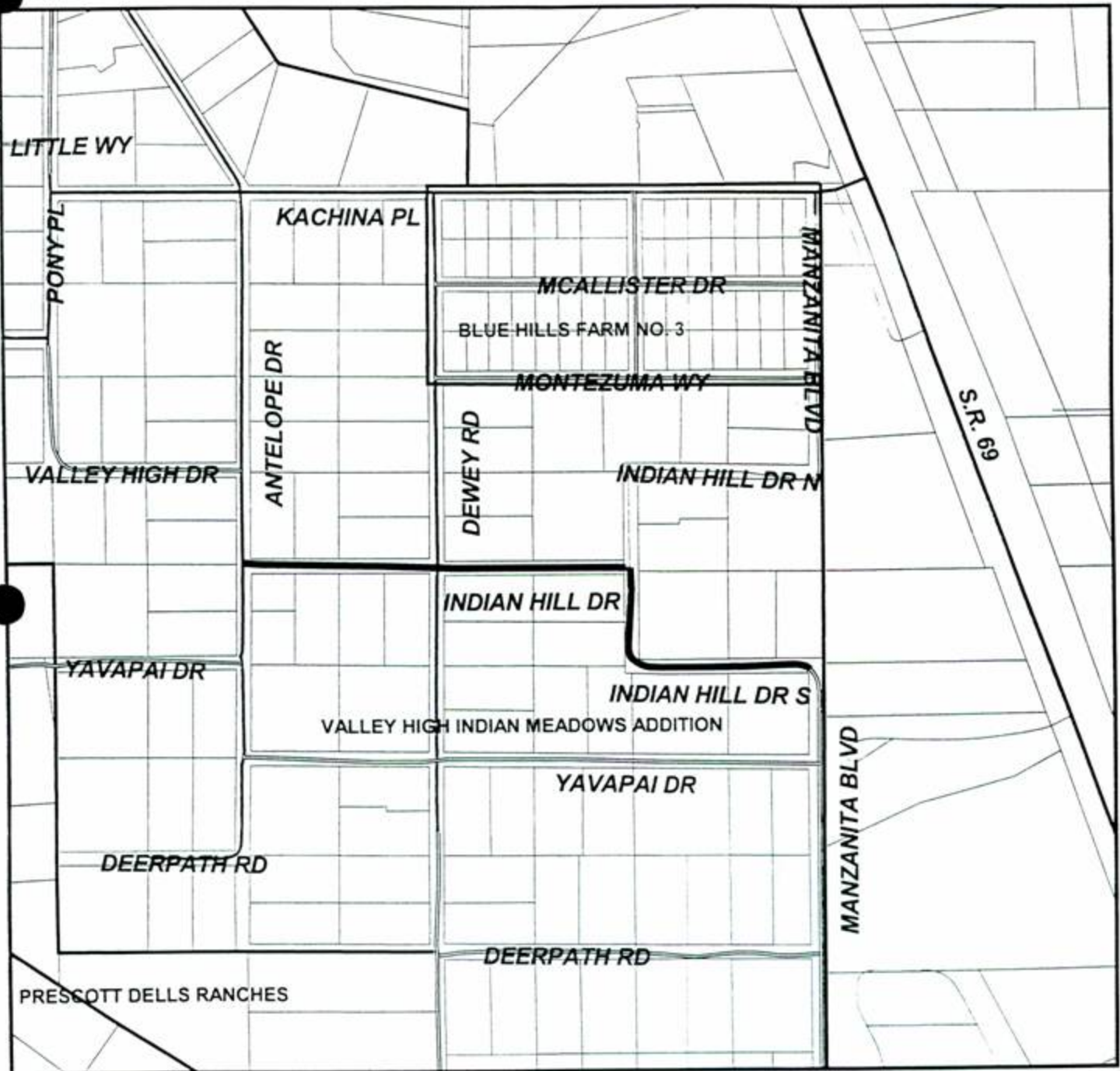

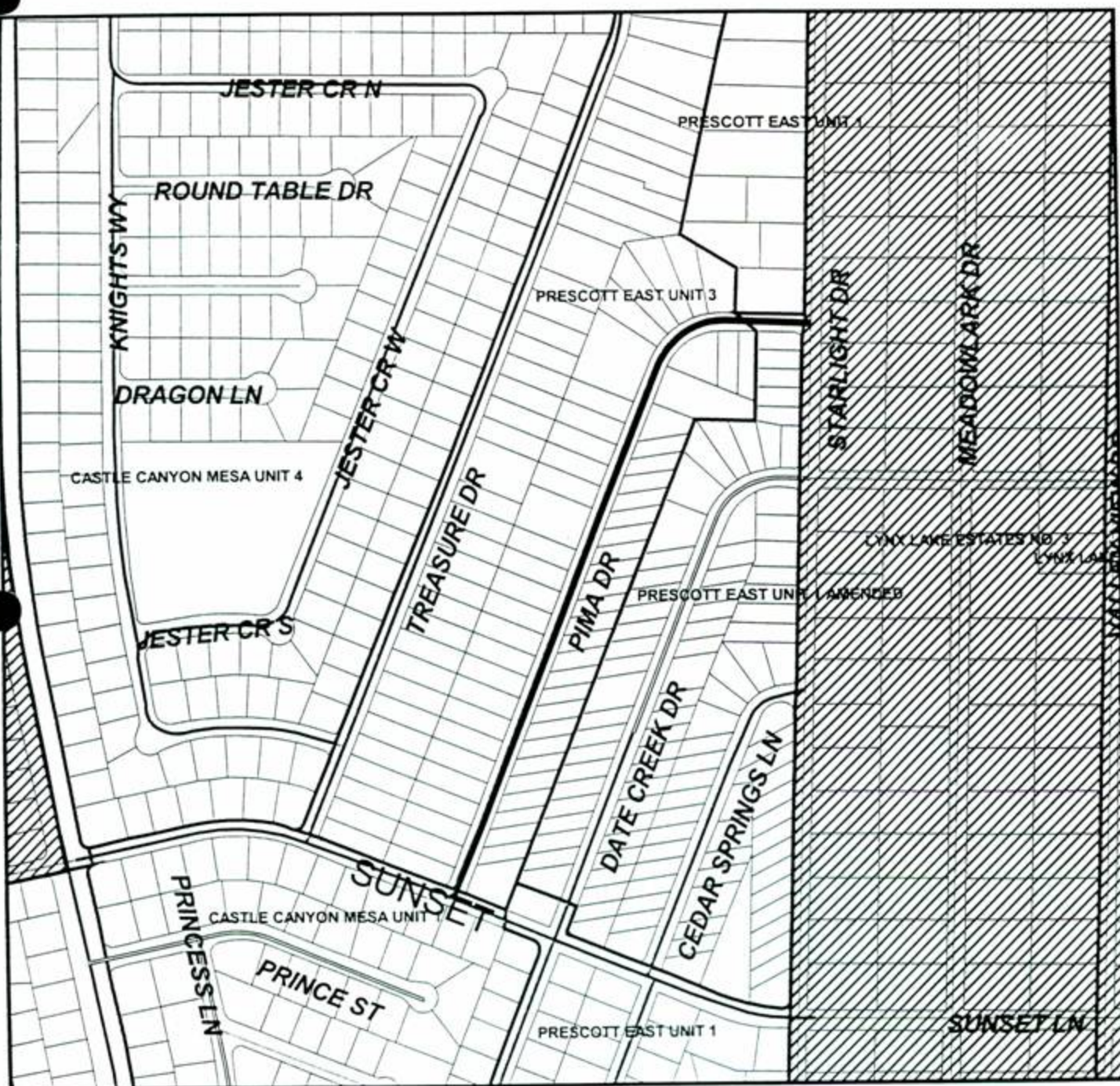

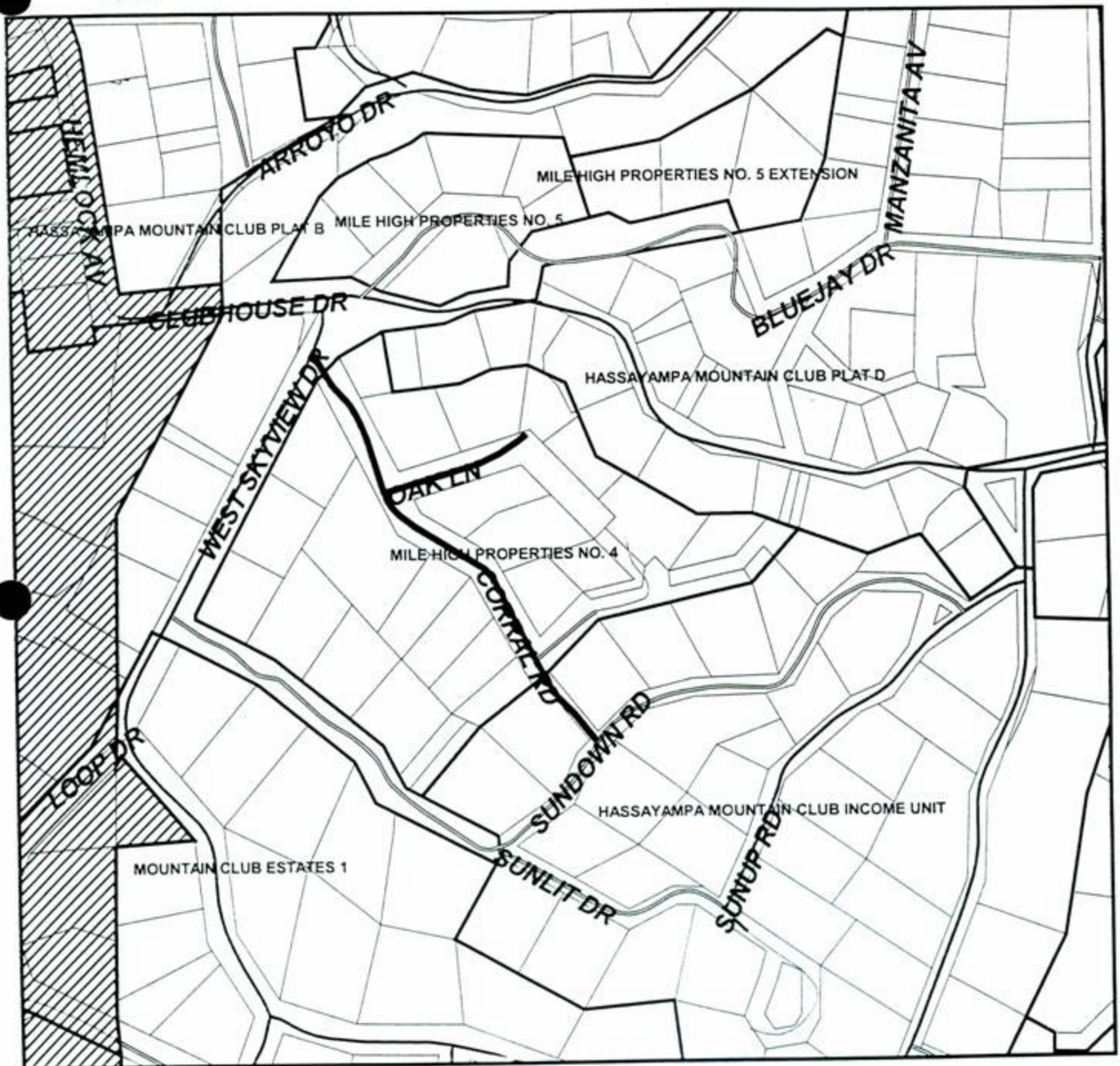
