

RESOLUTION NO. 1409

ESTABLISHING YUMA DRIVE AS A COUNTY HIGHWAY

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on September 2, 2003, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following road as a County highway is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of its establishment:

YUMA DRIVE, as shown in Book 48, Page 45 of Maps and Plats, on file in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona, beginning at its intersection with Road 5 North, thence Westerly, thence Northerly to the north section line of Section 31, Township 17 North, Range 2 West of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, and as shown on the attached Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the above described road, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be designated and established forthwith as a County highway.
