AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1285 & 1333

PAULDEN / CHINO VALLEY RURAL ADDRESS PROJECT STREET NAME MAP

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors were requested by the Addressing Unit of Development Services to adopt an official street name map for the Paulden / Chino Valley Rural Address Project area and rename certain streets in the project area, so as to improve public safety throughout the community;

Flagstone Drive, a portion of, as dedicated in Book 9 Page 43 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Flagstone Drive, running north / south, thence easterly to its intersection with the existing Limestone Drive, changed to Limestone Drive, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

Wineglass Road, in its entirety, as shown on a map on file in the office of the County Engineer, beginning at its intersection with Highway 89, thence northwesterly to a point on the western section line of Section 13, Township 18 North, and Range 3 West, changed to Big Chino Road, as shown on Exhibit B.

Rodrick Road, in its entirety, beginning at its intersection with Big Chino Road, thence southerly to its intersection with Bayberry Drive, changed to Big Springs Ranch Road, as shown on Exhibit C.

Big Springs Ranch Road, a portion of, beginning at its intersection with the Big Springs Ranch Road, running north/south, thence westerly to its intersection with Maraiah Lane, changed to Runway Road, as shown on Exhibit C.

Mohave Road, in its entirety, as dedicated in Book 7 Page 73 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Big Chino Road, thence northerly to its intersection with the existing Mitchell Lane, changed to Mitchell Lane, as shown on Exhibit D.

Hualapai Road, in its entirety, as dedicated in Book 7 Page 73 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Saddle Road, thence northerly to its intersection with the existing Patricia Road, changed to Patricia Road, as shown on Exhibit D.

Bayberry Drive, portions of, beginning at its intersection with Larita Road, thence easterly to its intersection with Mitchell Lane, then a second portion of Bayberry Drive, beginning at its intersection with Patricia Road, thence easterly to its intersection with Naples Street, both portions changed to Ranch House Road, as shown on Exhibit D.

Roughrider Trail, in its entirety, as dedicated in Book 20 Page 73 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Gunsite Road, thence northwesterly to its intersection with the existing Gunsite Road, **changed to Gunsite Road**, as shown on Exhibit E.

Gunsite Road, a portion of, as dedicated in Book 3 Page 21 on a Result of Survey, beginning at its intersection with Antelope Road, thence easterly to its intersection with Gunsite Road, changed to Unnamed Road, as shown on Exhibit E.

Morgan Ranch Road, in its entirety, beginning at its intersection with Old Highway 89, thence southeasterly to intersection with Kebey Trail, changed to Old Ranch Road, as shown on Exhibit F.

Spruce Drive, in its entirety, beginning at its intersection with Cedar Heights Road, thence northerly 1285 feet more or less, to its termination, changed to Tanner Mountain Road, as shown on Exhibit G.

Campbell Drive, in its entirety, as dedicated in Book 8 Page 83 of Maps and Plats and Book 847 page 153 of Official Records, beginning at its intersection with Yuma Drive, thence westerly to its intersection with Tanner Mountain Road, changed to Valley View, as shown on Exhibit G.

Pinon Avenue, in its entirety, as dedicated in Book 8 Page 83 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Yuma Drive, thence westerly to its intersection with Tanner Mountain Road, thence running west to its termination, **changed to Hidden Valley Lane**, as shown on Exhibit G.

Wolf Den Lane, in its entirety, beginning at its intersection with Little Ranch Road, thence running south to its termination, changed to an unnamed status, as shown on exhibit H.

A portion of Moon Shadow, beginning at its intersection with Little Ranch Road, thence running south to its termination, changed to Wolf Den Lane, as shown on exhibit H.

An Unnamed Road, in its entirety, beginning at its intersection with Little Ranch Road, thence running south to its termination, changed to Triple J Lane, as shown on exhibit H.

Triple J Lane, in its entirety, beginning at its intersection with Little Ranch Road, thence running south to its termination, changed to an unnamed status, as shown on exhibit H.

Windmill Lane, in its entirety, beginning at its intersection with Little Ranch Road, thence running south to its termination, changed to Windy Hill Lane, as shown on exhibit H.

Latigo Lane, in its entirety, beginning at its intersection with Hackamore Lane, thence running west to its termination, changed to Latigo Court, as shown on exhibit I.

End of Trail, in its entirety, beginning at its intersection with Rocky Road, thence running north to its termination, changed to Stagecoach Pass, as shown on exhibit J.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County declares the above described and illustrated on the attached exhibits, be officially renamed.

The Amended Official Street Name Map for the Paulden / Chino Valley Rural Address Project area is recorded in Book 46 Pages 58-59 of Maps and Plats.

All above recordations are on file in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County declares that the names of the streets as described above and as shown on Exhibit A – Exhibit J, be changed.

These name changes shall become effective 60 days after the date approved by the Board of Supervisors.
