WHEREAS, a public hearing was set for the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors to consider renaming Drexler Drive to Alta Mesa Drive;

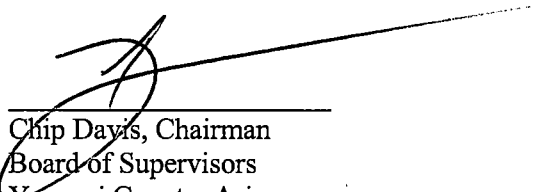
