

RESOLUTION NO. 1437

ESTABLISHING VARIOUS STREETS AS COUNTY HIGHWAYS

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on March 15, 2004, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following roads as County highways is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of their establishment:

SILVER KING CIRCLE, Groom Creek Pines Plat “C”, as dedicated in Book 9, Page 5 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Friendly Pines Road, thence northerly, thence westerly, thence easterly through Groom Creek Pines Plat “D”, as dedicated in Book 12, Page 80 of Maps and Plats, thence southeasterly to the south subdivision boundary line, and as shown on the attached Exhibit “A”.

PONDEROSA PARKWAY, Groom Creek Pines Plat “D”, as dedicated in Book 12, Page 80 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Silver King Circle, thence northerly, thence easterly to its terminus in a cul-de-sac, and as shown on the attached Exhibit “A”.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the above described roads, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A, be designated and established forthwith as County highways.

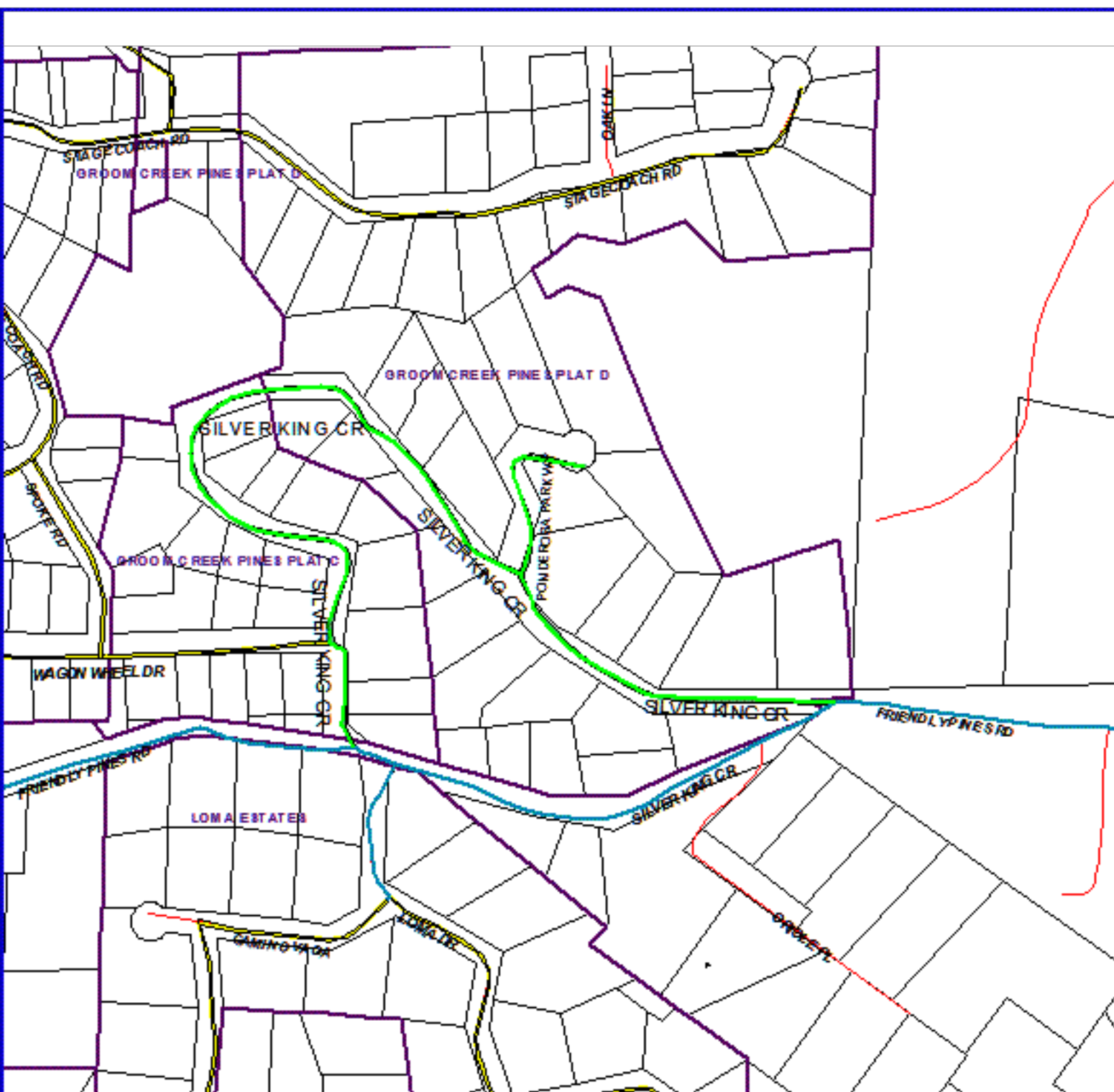
