RESOLUTION NO. 1449

ESTABLISHING SEVERAL STREETS AND ROADS AS COUNTY HIGHWAYS

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on August 2, 2004, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following roads as County highways is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of their establishment:

AIRPORT DRIVE, formerly known as Jo Ann Drive, Rimrock Acres - II, as dedicated in Book 8 page 47 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Airport Drive, thence northeasterly to Lot 49, and as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

BEAVER VISTA ROAD, Beaver Vista Acres Unit Two, as dedicated in Book 6 page 77 of Maps and Plats, formerly known as Cottonwood Drive, beginning at its intersection with Lake Shore Drive, thence northwesterly, thence northwesterly through Beaver Vista Acres, as dedicated in Book 6 page 55 of Maps and Plats, thence northeasterly, thence northeasterly through The Sycamores, as dedicated in Book 6 Page 63 of Maps and Plats, to its intersection with Chipmunk Hollow, and as shown on the attached Exhibit B.

RIVER BEND ROAD, as shown in Book 50 page 52 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Salt Mine Road, thence easterly to its intersection with Fisherman's Road, and as shown on the attached Exhibit C.

SOUTH ASPAAS ROAD, as shown on a map on file in the Yavapai County Special Districts Office, beginning at the south boundary of Creek Vista Subdivision, as shown in Book 9 page 29 of Maps and Plats, thence southerly to the south boundary of Section 10, Township 15 North, Range 4 East of the G&SRB&M, and as shown on the attached Exhibit D.

SWEETWATER DRIVE, formerly known as Kramer Avenue, Lake Montezuma Hills, as dedicated in Book 12 page 95 of Maps and Plats, beginning at its intersection with Valley Vista Road, thence easterly to its intersection with Montezuma Avenue, and as shown on the attached Exhibit B.

All above stated recordations on file in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the above described roads, and as shown on the attached Exhibits "A", "B", "C", and "D" be designated and established forthwith as County highways.

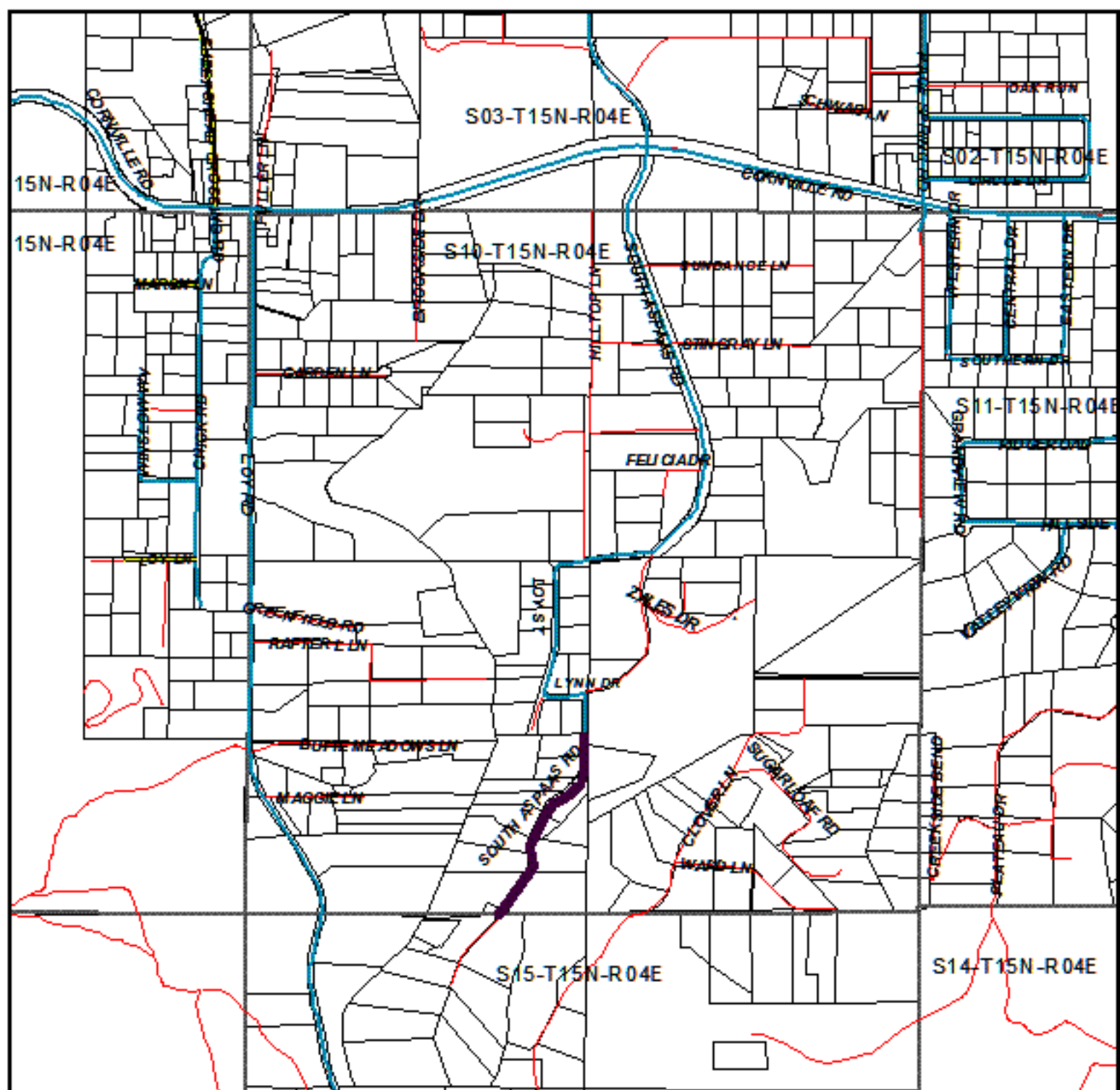

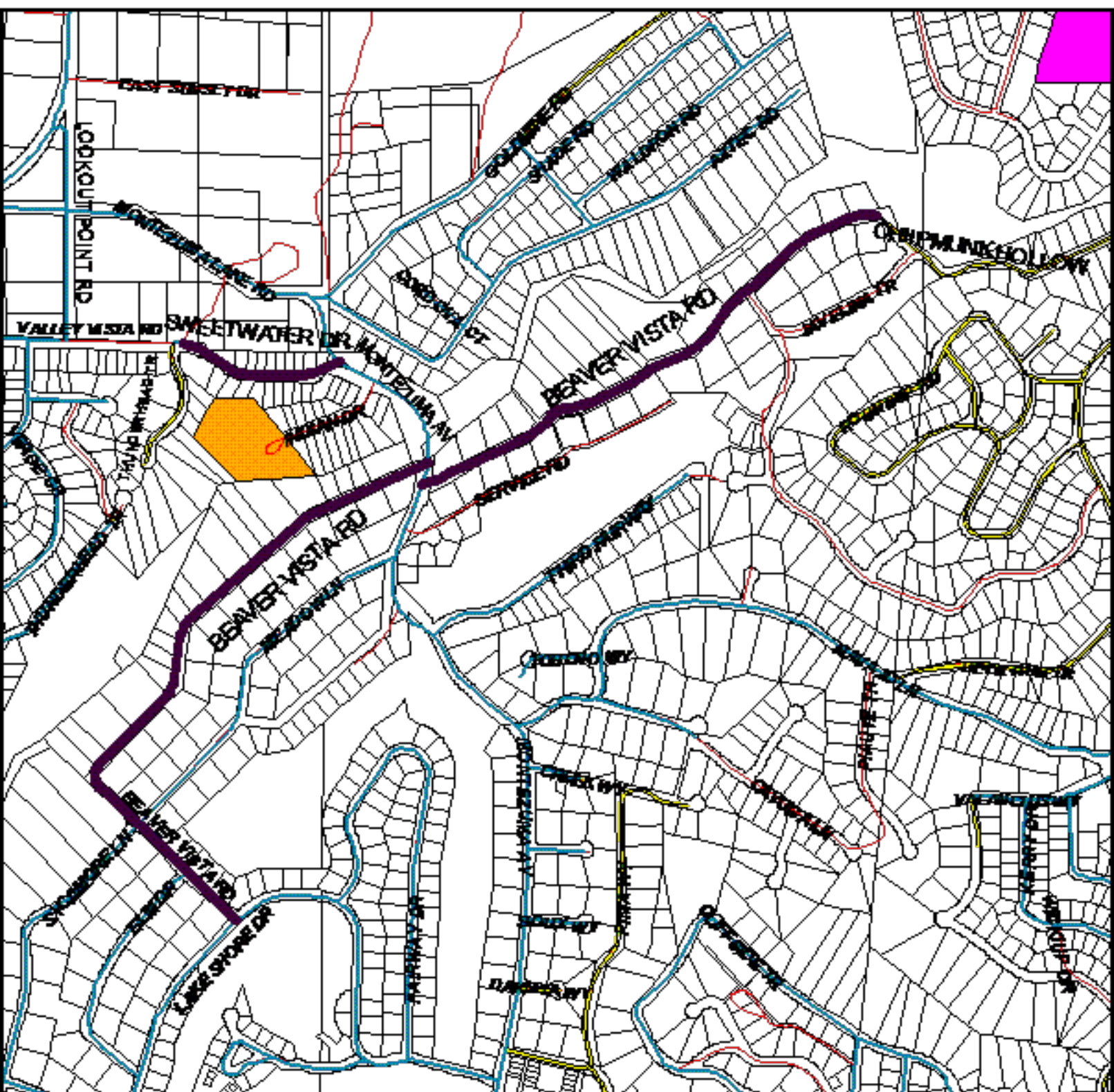
