RESOLUTION NO. 1595

OLD BLACK CANYON HIGHWAY, RIGHT OF WAY EXTINGUISHMENT

The above matter came before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its meeting on October 3, 2005, at the request of BLACK CANYON FIRE DEPARTMENT to extinguish a portion of public road right of way across Bureau of Land Management lands, pursuant to A.R.S. §28-7214, and as further described on the attached Exhibit A.

The County Engineer has recommended the extinguishment of said portion of public road right of way for the new Fire Station on Old Black Canyon Highway. The Board of Supervisors determined that the extinguishment of said portion of public road right of way will not leave any property without access to public roads and streets of Yavapai County, and is no longer necessary for public use, and the same should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: (1) that the request for extinguishment of said portion of right of way for the Black Canyon Fire Station, as described above, pursuant to A.R.S. §28-7214, be approved; (2) that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded along with a plat map in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.
