RESOLUTION NO. 1627

ESTABLISHING SEVERAL STREETS AND ROADS AS COUNTY HIGHWAYS

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on October 16, 2006, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following roads as County highways is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of their establishment:

Rainbow Drive:

A portion of Section 10, Township 15 North, Range 3 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Yavapai County, Arizona, described as follows:

A strip of land, 25 feet wide, being the East 25 feet of the North half, of the Northwest quarter, of the Northeast quarter, of the Southwest quarter of said Section 10.

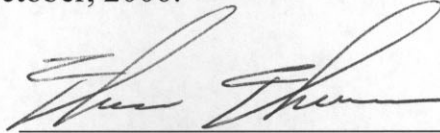
Peila Avenue:

A portion of Section 10, Township 15 North, Range 3 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Yavapai County, Arizona, described as follows:

A strip of land, 25 feet wide, being the North 25 feet of the North half, of the Northwest quarter, of the Northeast quarter, of the Southwest quarter of said Section 10.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the above described roads, and as shown on the attached Exhibit "A", be designated and established forthwith as County highways.

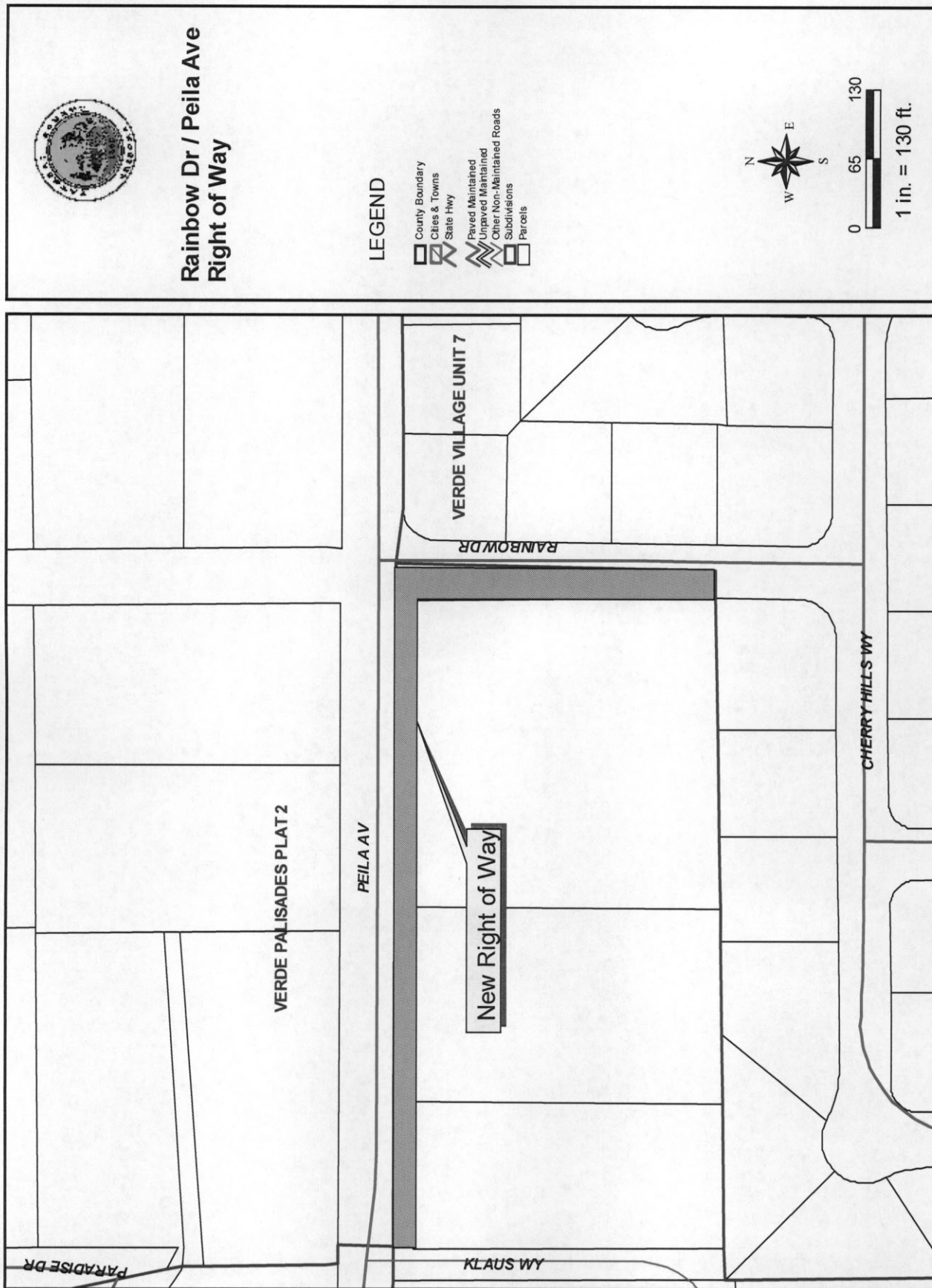
