RESOLUTION NO. 1659

ESTABLISHING CEDAR DRIVE AS A COUNTY HIGHWAY

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on November 5, 2007, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following road as a County highway is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of its establishment:

CEDAR DRIVE, in Oak Knoll Village, as shown in Book 11, Page 4 of Maps & Plats, beginning at its intersection with Woodland Drive, thence southeasterly, thence northerly to its intersection with Woodland Drive.

All above stated recordations are on record at the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the above described road, and as shown on the attached Exhibit “A”, be designated and established forthwith as a County highway.

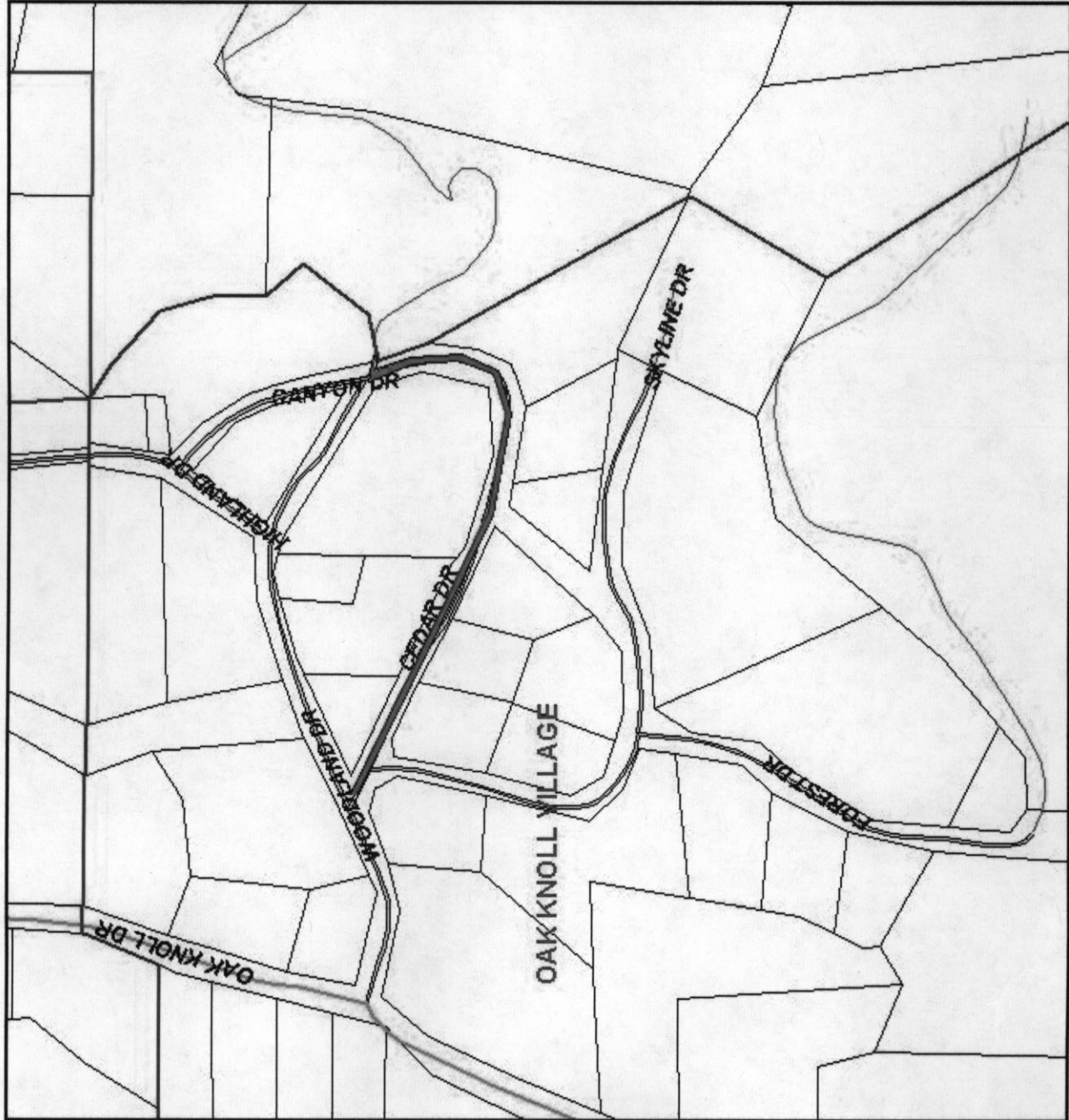
