KINISHBA FIRE TRAIL TO AGAVE MEADOW WAY & BATTLE FIRE DRIVE TO AZUZA TRAIL PUMPKIN FIRE ROAD TO KOKEPELLI ROAD & CHEDESKI FIRE LANE TO TACK HOUSE ROAD

WHEREAS, Talking Rock Land LLC & the individual property owners submitted four petitions to rename four streets adjacent to their properties in Talking Rock Ranch Phase 9, in the Williamson Valley area;

WHEREAS, the petitions included the filing fees necessary to accept to the petitions;

WHEREAS, the property owners accessing Kinishba Fire Trail, Battle Fire Drive, Pumpkin Fire Road, and Chedeski Fire Lane expressed the need to rename the roadways due to the negative connotations which relate to past Arizona fires;

Kinishba Fire Trail, in its entirety, as dedicated and recorded in Book 52 Pages 55-56, **changed to Agave Meadow Way**, as shown on Exhibit A.

Battle Fire Drive, in its entirety, as dedicated and recorded in Book 52 Pages 57-59, **changed to Azuza Trail**, as shown on Exhibit A.

Pumpkin Fire Road, in its entirety, as dedicated and recorded in Book 52 Pages 57-59, **changed to Kokepelli Road**, as shown on Exhibit B.

Chedeski Fire Lane, in its entirety, as dedicated and recorded in Book 54 Pages 8-9, **changed to Tack House Road**, as shown on Exhibit C.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was set for the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors to consider renaming Kinishba Fire Trail to Agave Meadow Way, Battle Fire Drive to Azuza Trail, Pumpkin Fire Road to Kokepelli Road, and Chedeski Fire Lane to Tack House Road;

WHEREAS, a notice of hearing was printed in the Prescott Courier on April 27, 2008, posted along the referenced street, mailed out to the Yavapai County Sheriff's Office, Central Yavapai Fire District, Public Works Department, and the adjacent property owners to the above referenced streets;

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on May 5, 2008;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County declares that streets as described above and as illustrated on the attached Exhibits A-C, be changed.

This street name change shall become effective 60-days after the date approved by the Board of Supervisors.
