to A.R.S. §28-7203; (3) that the abandonment of a portion of Manzanita Ave., Mile High

Properties No. 4, Yavapai County, Arizona, shown on the attached Exhibit "A", be and

the same is granted and shall vest in the petitioner, (4) that rights of way or easements

of existing sewer, gas, water or similar pipelines and appurtenances and for canals,

laterals or ditches and appurtenances, and for electric, telephone, and similar lines and

appurtenances shall continue as they existed prior to the exchange and abandonment;

and (5) that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded along with an exchange

and abandonment map in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.
