RESOLUTION NO. 1733

CANCELING ELECTION FOR CONGRESS DOMESTIC WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND APPOINTING THE PERSON WHO FILED A NOMINATING PETITION

WHEREAS, only two positions on the board of directors for Congress Domestic Water District were open for election and only one person filed a nominating petition; and

WHEREAS, the district has requested that the Board of Supervisors cancel the election and appoint the person who filed a nominating petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the May 18, 2010, election for board of directors in the Congress Domestic Water Improvement District is cancelled and appoint Ralph E. Anderson who filed a nominating petition.
